## ANNOUNCEMENT OF NEW APPOINTMENTS AND REASSIGNMENTS TO ENHANCE SERVICE DELIVERY

Sarah Malit (Ms.) will now manage Blue Economy, Fisheries, Mining, and Digital Economy.

## **Reassignments of Chief Officers**

Diana Anyango Ongere (Ms.) has moved from Education to Water, Sanitation, Environment, Energy, Forestry, and Climate Change.

Benard Ouru Nyobange (Eng.) has transitioned from Roads and Transport to Trade, Investments, Industrialization, Tourism, and Marketing.
